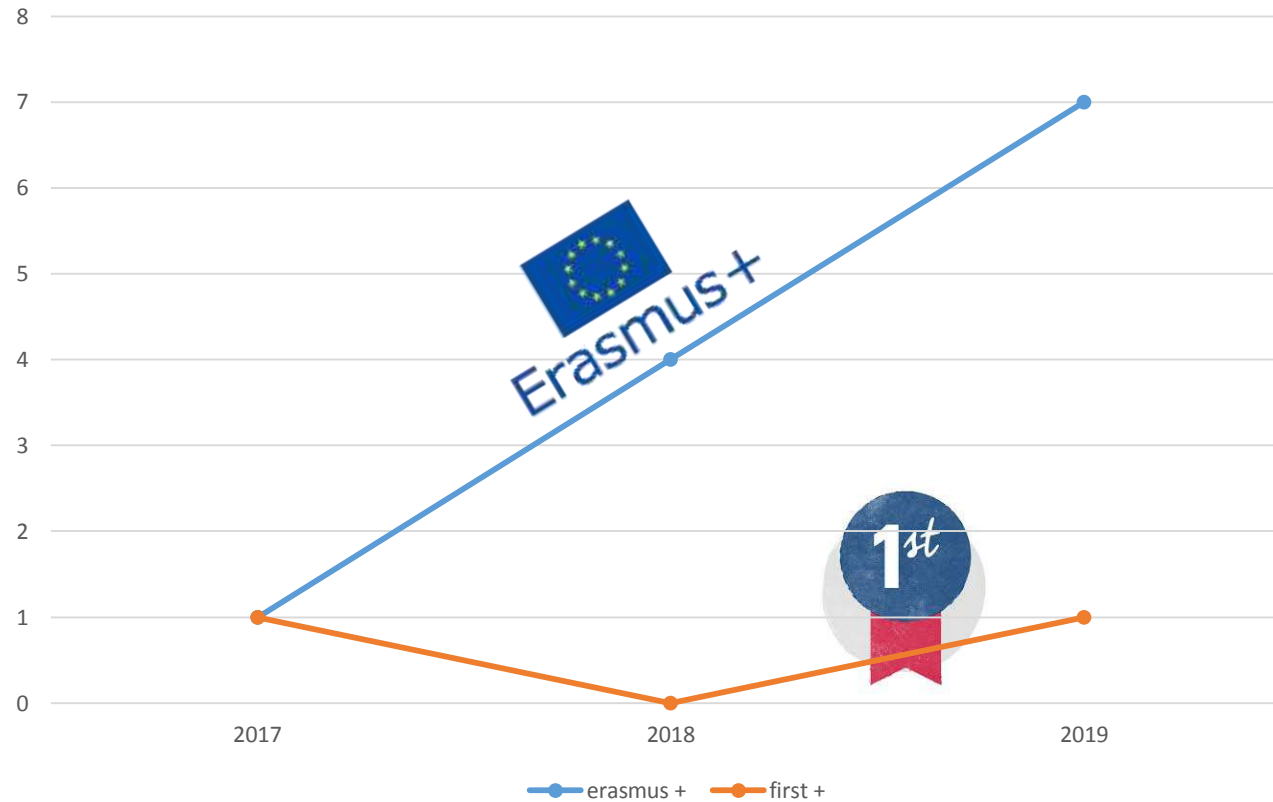

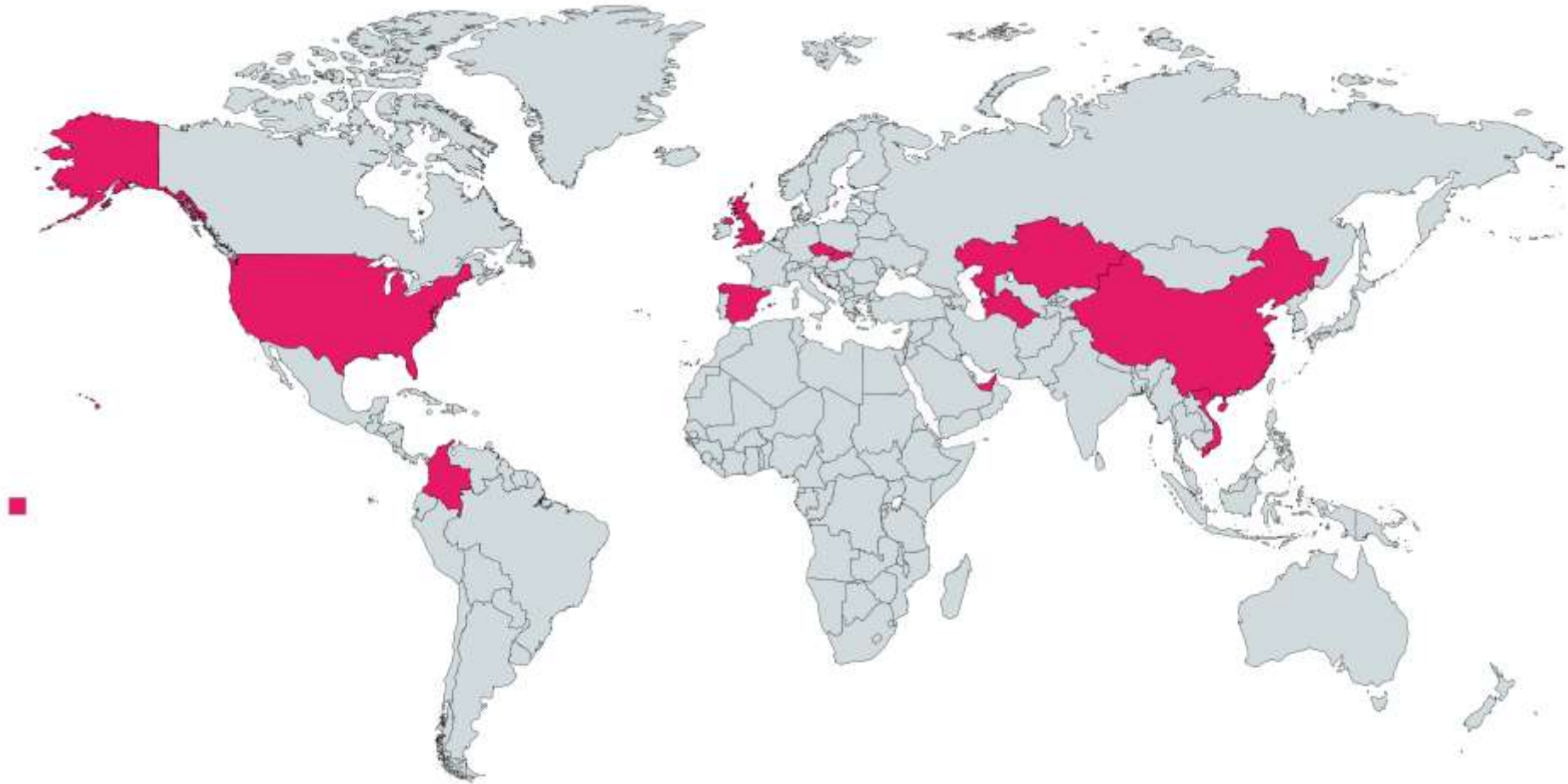

# Major academic mobility programmes 2017-2019

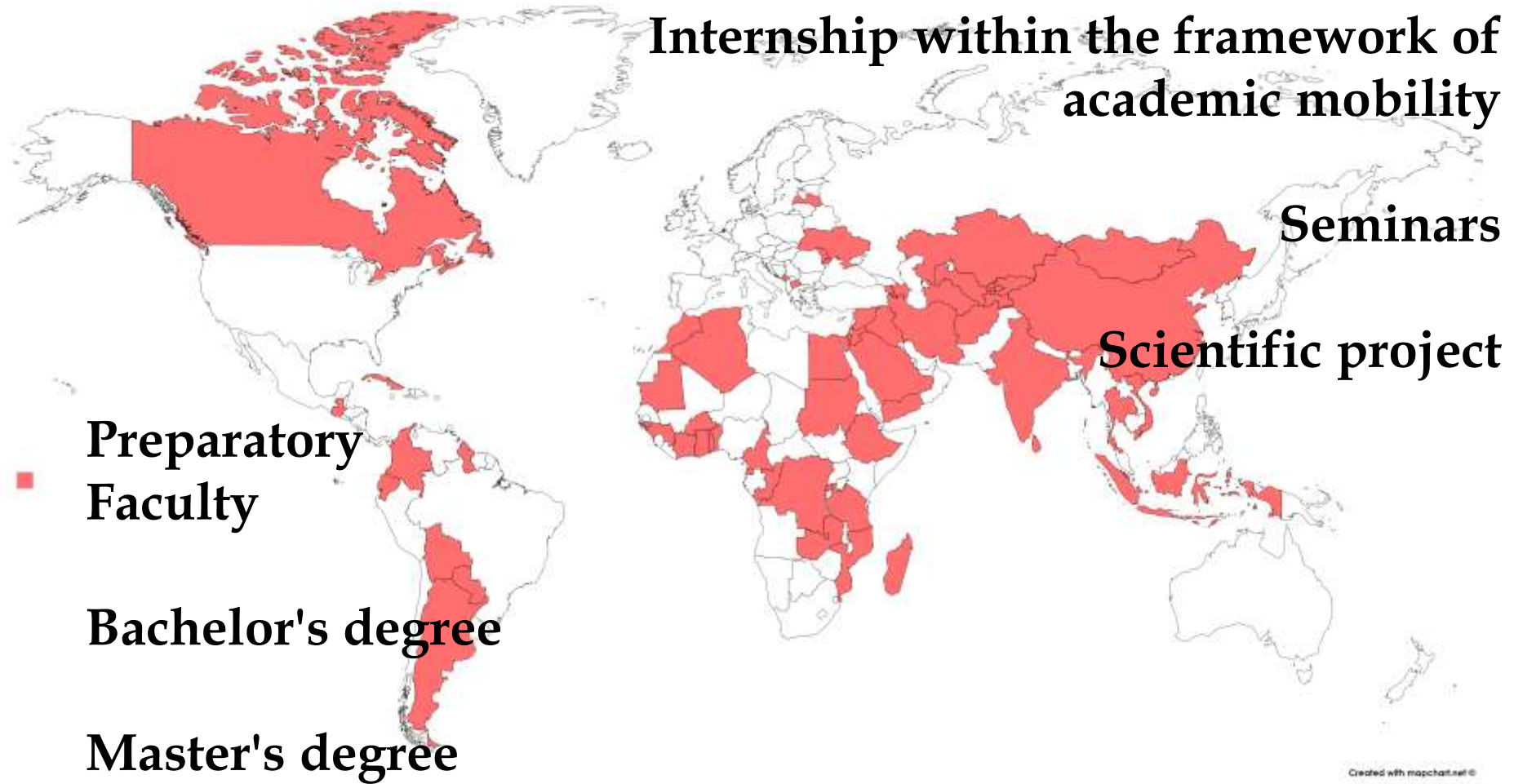
